- This class will be physically demanding, including timed immersion suit donning, entering the water, then into a liferaft, starting pumps, putting out fires, etc.
- Expect to sign a liability waiver
- Bring rain gear, change of clothes and a towel
- Bring your own survival suit if you have one (we have extras for those who don't)
